

John 14:27 (NASB)

27 Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Isaiah 9:6-7 (NASB)

6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, **Prince of Peace**. 7 There will be **no end** to the increase of *His* government or **of peace**, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

[Salvation]

Romans 5:1 (NASB) Therefore, having been **justified by faith**, we **have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ**, (Salvation – Eternal Life)

Colossians 1:19-20 (NASB)

19 For it was the *Father's* good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, 20 and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, **having made peace through the blood of His cross**; through Him, *I say*, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

Romans 15:13 (NASB) Now may the God of hope fill you with all **joy and peace in believing**, so that **you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit**.

John 16:33 (NASB) "These things I have spoken to you, so that **in Me you may have peace**. In the world you have tribulation but take courage; I have overcome the world."

Romans 1:7 (NASB) to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called *as* saints: **Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ**.

Psalms 29:11 (NASB) The LORD will give strength to His people; **The LORD will bless His people with peace**.

Isaiah 54:13 (KJV) And all thy children *shall be* taught of the LORD; and **great shall be the peace of thy children**.

Isaiah 57:19 (KJV) I create the fruit of the lips; **Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near**, saith the LORD; and **I will heal him**.

Romans 5:10 (NASB) For if while we were enemies **we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son**, much more, having been reconciled, **we shall be saved by His life**.

[Greetings-Many times in the beginning of letters]

1 Corinthians 1:3 (NASB)

3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

[Closings]

2 Thessalonians 3:16 (NASB)

16 Now may the Lord of peace Himself continually grant you peace in every circumstance. The Lord be with you all!

2 Corinthians 5:18-21 (KJV) [To Be Shared]

18 And all things *are* of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. 21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

[To Guard us]

Philippians 4:7 (NASB)

7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

[Leads to Good Works]

Hebrews 13:20-21 (KJV) 20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom *be* glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Isaiah 32:15-17 (NASB)

15 Until the Spirit is poured out upon us from on high, And the wilderness becomes a fertile field, And the fertile field is considered as a forest. 16 Then justice will dwell in the wilderness And righteousness will abide in the fertile field. 17 And the work of righteousness will be peace, And the service of righteousness, quietness and confidence forever.

Luke 1:79 (NASB) TO SHINE UPON THOSE WHO SIT IN DARKNESS AND THE SHADOW OF DEATH, To guide our feet into the way of peace."

Luke 2:14 (NASB) "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased."

Acts 10:36 (NASB) "The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—

John 20:21 (NASB) So Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

Romans 8:6 (NASB) For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace,

[Brings Confidence in Testings and Trials- Faith Casts out Fear]

Psalm 27:1 (NASB) The LORD is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The LORD is the defense of my life; Whom shall I dread?

Psalm 56:3 (NASB) When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You.

Psalm 56:11 (NASB) In God I have put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Psalm 112:5-7 (NASB)

5 It is well with the man who is gracious and lends; He will maintain his cause in judgment. 6 For he will never be shaken; The righteous will be remembered forever. 7 He will not fear evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD.

Isaiah 12:2 (NASB) "Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; For the LORD GOD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation."

Isaiah 41:10 (NASB) 'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

Acts 18:9-10 (NASB)

9 And the Lord said to Paul in the night by a vision, "Do not be afraid *any longer*, but go on speaking and do not be silent; 10 for I am with you, and no man will attack you in order to harm you, for I have many people in this city."

2 Timothy 1:7-9 (KJV)

7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. 8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; 9 Who hath saved us, and called *us* with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

[Calls us to Unity]

Colossians 3:15-17 (NASB) 15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. 17 Whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

Ephesians 2:14-17 (NASB)

14 For He Himself is our peace, who made both *groups into* one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall, 15 by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, *which is* the Law of commandments *contained* in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, *thus* establishing peace, 16 and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity. 17 AND HE CAME AND PREACHED PEACE TO YOU WHO WERE FAR AWAY, AND PEACE TO THOSE WHO WERE NEAR;

[Fruit of the Spirit]

Galatians 5:22-23 (NASB)

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

The Gospel: A Biblical Plan of Salvation

1. Man is sinful. – (We must realize that we are not perfect.)
Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."
2. The Penalty of Sin is Death – (God's Justice requires a payment for sin.)
Romans 6:23 " For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
3. God's Holiness requires perfection – (Holiness cannot tolerate sin.)
Revelation 21:27 "And there shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie; but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life."
4. Man cannot earn perfection – (We cannot make ourselves PERFECT) *
Ephesians 2:8,9 " For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God; Not of works, lest any man should boast."
5. Christ made the complete payment for all sin and offers His Righteousness.– (We need the Perfection/Righteousness of God to go to Heaven.)
2 Cor. 5:21 "For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of god in Him."
6. God only requires Faith for salvation (Believe, Trust Accept, Etc.)
John 3:16 " For God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."
7. A believer can know Now that he is Eternally Saved
1 John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."
