## Paul's Example

#### 1 Corinthians 9:11-23 (NASB)

11 If we sowed spiritual things in you, is it too much if we reap material things from you? 12 If others share the right over you, do we not more? Nevertheless, we did not use this right, but we endure all things <u>so that we will cause no hindrance to the</u> gospel of Christ. 13 Do you not know that those who perform sacred services eat the *food* of the temple, *and* those who attend regularly to the altar have their share from the altar? 14 So also the Lord directed those who proclaim the gospel to get their living from the gospel. 15 But I have used none of these things. And I am not writing these things so that it will be done so in my case; for it would be better for me to die than have any man make my boast an empty one. 16 For <u>if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for I am under compulsion; for woe is me if I do not preach the gospel. I7 For if I do this voluntarily, I have a reward; but if against my will, I have a stewardship entrusted to me. 18 What then is my reward? That, <u>when I preach the gospel. I may offer the gospel without charge</u>, so as not to make full use of my right in the gospel.</u>

19 For though I am free from all *men*, I have made myself a slave to all, so that I may win more. 20 To the Jews I became as a Jew, so that I might win Jews; to those who are under the Law, as under the Law though not being myself under the Law, so that I might win those who are under the Law; 21 to those who are without law, as without law, though not being without the law of God but under the law of Christ, so that I might win those who are without law. 22 To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak; I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some. 23 I do all things for the sake of the gospel, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it.

<u>Acts 20:26</u> Wherefore I take you to record this day, <u>that I am pure from the blood of all men.</u><sup>27</sup> For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God.

#### Revelation 2:4-5 (KJV)

**4** Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou hast <u>left thy first love</u>. **5** Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and <u>do the first works</u>; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

#### A BIBLICAL PLAN OF SALVATION WITH KEY VERSES. BAD NEWS

- Man is Sinful. (We must realize that we are not 100% perfect) Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."
- 2.) <u>The Penalty of Sin is Death.</u> (God's Justice requires a payment for Sin.) Romans 6:23 "For the wages of Sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
- 3.) <u>God's Holiness Requires Perfection.</u> (*Holiness cannot tolerate sin.*) **Revelation 21:27** "And there shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whosoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie; but they which are written in the Lamb's Book of Life."
- 4.) Man Cannot Earn Perfection. (We cannot make ourselves perfect.)
   Ephesians 2:8,9 "For by Grace are ye saved through Faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the Gift of God; Not of works, lest any man should boast."

# GOOD NEWS

- 5.) Christ Paid Completely for All Sin & Offers His Righteousness. (We need the Perfection/Righteousness of God to go to Heaven.)
  2 Corinthians 5:21 "For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the Righteousness of God in Him."
- 6.) God only Requires Faith for Salvation. (Believe, Trust, Accept, etc.) John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, the whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting Life."
- 7.) <u>A Believer can Know Now that he is Eternally Saved.</u>
  1 John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that <u>believe</u> on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."
