#### Ephesians 6:10-20 (KJV)

<sup>10</sup> Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. <sup>11</sup> Put on the <u>whole</u> armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of

**the devil.** <sup>12</sup> For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. <sup>13</sup> Wherefore take unto you **the whole armour of God**, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. <sup>14</sup> **stand therefore**, having your **loins** girt about with **truth**, and having on the **breastplate of righteousness**;

God's purpose for us is to be "Conformed to the image of His Son." [Romans 8:29]

## Philippians 2:5-13

## <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

<sup>6</sup> Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: <sup>7</sup> <u>But</u> <u>made himself of no reputation</u>, and took upon him the form of a <u>servant</u>, and was made in the likeness of men:

**9** Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: **10** That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; **11** And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

# Philippians 4:6-9 (KJV)

6 Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall <u>keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.</u>

8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true,

whatsoever things are honest, [worthy of reverence] [honorable]

whatsoever things *are* just, [righteous]

whatsoever things are pure,

whatsoever things are lovely,

whatsoever things are of good report; [attractive] [commendable]

if there be any virtue, [excellence]

and if there be any praise, [subject of careful reflection]

# think on these things.

9 Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

# **Glorify God**

**<u>Romans 15:5-7</u>** (<u>Wuest</u>) Now, the God of the patience and the encouragement give to you to be thinking the same thing among one another according to Christ Jesus, in order that with <u>one mind and one mouth</u> you may keep <u>on glorifying the God and</u> <u>Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.</u> Wherefore, be receiving one another even as also the Christ received us.

# One Mind-God's

#### Philippians 2:1-4 (KJV)

1 If *there be* therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, 2 Fulfil ye my joy, that ye <u>be</u> <u>likeminded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind.</u> 3 *Let* nothing *be done* through strife or vainglory; but in <u>lowliness of mind let each esteem other</u> <u>better than themselves</u>. 4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

### Unity of Mind

### Romans 12:16-21 (NASB)

16 Be of the <u>same mind toward one another</u>; <u>do not be haughty in mind</u>, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation. 17 Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men. 18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men. 19 Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath *of God*, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord. 20 "BUT IF YOUR ENEMY IS HUNGRY, FEED HIM, AND IF HE IS THIRSTY, GIVE HIM A DRINK; FOR IN SO DOING YOU WILL HEAP BURNING COALS ON HIS HEAD." 21 Do not be overcome by evil, but <u>overcome evil with good.</u>

# **RENEWING OUR MIND**

### Romans 12:1-2 (NASB)

1 Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind**, so that you may prove what **the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.** 

### Ephesians 4:22-24 (NASB)

22 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you **lay aside the old self**, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, 23 and that you **be renewed in the spirit of your mind**, 24 and **put on the new self**, which in *the likeness of* God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

# Set your mind on the things above [The Eternal]

# Colossians 3:1-17 (NASB)

1 Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. 3 For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory. 5 Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry. 6 For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience, 7 and in them you also once walked, when you were living in them. 8 But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its *evil* practices, 10 and have **put on the new** self who is being **renewed to a true** knowledge according to the image of the One who created him—11 a renewal in which there is no distinction between Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all. 12 So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;

13 bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. 14 Beyond all these things *put* on love, which is the perfect bond of unity. 15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. 17 Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

#### *How do we protect our mind?*

Be careful what you put into your mind. What we put in our mind should be filtered through SALVATION. THE WORD OF GOD

#### A BIBLICAL PLAN OF SALVATION WITH KEY VERSES.

- 1.) <u>Man is Sinful</u>. (We must realize that we are not 100% perfect) **Romans 3:23** "For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God."
- 2.) <u>The Penalty of Sin is Death.</u> (God's Justice requires a payment for Sin.) **Romans 6:23** "For the wages of Sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
- 3.) God's Holiness Requires Perfection. (Holiness cannot tolerate sin.) Revelation 21:27 "And there shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whosoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie; but they which are written in the Lamb's Book of Life."
- 4.) <u>Man Cannot Earn Perfection</u>. (We cannot make ourselves perfect.) Ephesians 2:8,9 "For by Grace are ye saved through Faith; and that not Of yourselves: it is the Gift of God,; Not of works, lest any man should boast."
- 5.) <u>Christ Paid Completely for All Sin & Offers His Righteousness.</u> (We need the Perfection/Righteousness of God to go to Heaven.)
  2 Corinthians 5:21 "For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the Righteousness of God in Him."
- 6.) <u>God only Requires Faith for Salvation.</u> (Believe, Trust, Accept, etc.) John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, the <u>whosoever</u> believeth in Him should not perish, but have Everlasting Life."
- 7.) A Believer can Know Now that he is Eternally Saved.

**1 John 5:13** "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."
